ORDINANCE NO. 2017-08

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING §73.05(G) AND
ENACTING §73.06 OF THE
CALVERT CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES,
RELATING TO THE OPERATION OF
GOLF CARTS ON CITY'S MULTI-USE PATH

WHEREAS the City has designed and constructed a multi-use path leading from the intersection of 5th Avenue and Hickory Street to the intersection of Lone Valley Road and Kentucky Highway 62 for the purpose of facilitating personal exercise and recreation within the City; and,

WHEREAS the multi-use trail is situated and located so as to provide access to the city's parks system, the Calvert City Country Club, and the Ford Square commercial area; and,

WHEREAS the City Council has considered the potential use of the trail and has determined that pedestrians, bicycles, other non-motorized vehicles, and slowing moving golf carts should be allowed to operate upon the multi-use path; and,

WHEREAS §73.05(G) currently prohibits the use of golf carts upon walking trails located within the City.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF CALVERT CITY, COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY, that amends §73.05(G) and enacts §73.06, as follows:

§ 73.05 OPERATION OF ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES ON CITY STREETS

- (G) A person shall not operate any all terrain vehicle upon or within any sidewalk, walking trail or other pedestrian walkway, except as specifically allowed by §71.04 and §73.06 of these ordinances.

§ 73.06 OPERATION OF GOLF CARTS ON MULTI-USE PATH

- (A) For purposes of this section, "Golf Cart" means any self-propelled vehicle that:

1. Is designed for the transportation of players or maintaining equipment on a golf course, while engaged in the playing of golf, supervising the play of golf, or maintaining the condition of the grounds on a golf course;
 2. Has a minimum of four (4) wheels;
 3. Is designed to operate at a speed of not more than twenty-five (25) miles per hour;
 4. Is designed to carry not more than six (6) persons, including the driver;
 5. Has a maximum gross vehicle weight of two thousand five hundred (2,500) pounds;
 6. Has a maximum rated payload capacity of one thousand two hundred (1,200) pounds; and
- (B) Golf carts may be operated upon the City's multi-use path, during daylight hours, from the point where such path adjoins Hickory Street to the point where such path adjoins Kentucky Highway 62.
- (C) All golf carts operated upon the City's multi-use path shall be operated only by persons possessing a driver's license issued by the Commonwealth of Kentucky for the operation of motor vehicles upon streets and roadways within the Commonwealth.
- (D) Golf carts being operated upon the City's multi-use path shall at all times yield to any and all pedestrian use and all other vehicles of any description legally using the path and public areas surrounding the path.
