UNDERSTANDING CALVERT CITY'S SPECIAL PICKUP

GARBAGE COLLECTION

Route 1: Monday and Thursday **Route 2:** Tuesday and Friday

Calvert City offers a variety of services to keep our community clean, safe, and beautiful. Please review the information below to help ensure your items are collected properly and on schedule. By following these guidelines, we can work together to keep Calvert City looking its best all year long!

YARD WASTE & HOUSEHOLD BULK PICKUP

The city offers Yard Waste and Household Bulk pickup on alternating months. Place items within five feet of the edge of the road, but not in the street. Keep Yard Waste and Household Bulk Waste in separate piles—mixed piles will not be picked up.

Yard Waste Collection includes:

- Basic limbs and leaves
- Tree sections cut by the homeowner
(Must be cut into 3-foot sections)

Yard Waste Collection does NOT include:

- Entire trees removed by contractors
(Contractor must haul away debris)
- Large tree stumps or oversized logs
- Construction debris

Household Bulk Collection includes:

- Furniture (couches, tables, chairs)
- Appliances (refrigerators, washers, dryers)
- Mattresses and box springs
- Fencing: Wire fencing must be bundled and secured. Wood fencing must be cut into manageable pieces.

Household Bulk Collection does NOT include:

- Hazardous waste
- Construction materials
- Loose debris or bagged household trash

LOOSE LEAF VACUUM COLLECTION

Calvert City's loose leaf vacuum collection begins **November 17 and ends January 12**. Routes follow the same schedule as regular garbage collection, meaning if you are **Route 1 or Route 2 for garbage**, you are the same for leaf collection. Residents are asked to rake their leaves within **five feet** of the edge of the road, as the vacuum hose can only reach that distance, and city crews will not drive into yards. Any leaves not collected by January 12 must be bagged by the homeowner. **Free leaf bags are available for residents at City Hall.**
